# Academic Calendar for the Session 2026-2027

In pursuance of the instructions issued by the Department of Education, Government of Assam, for the preparation of a uniform Academic calendar for Elementary, Secondary and Higher Secondary classes and its implementation in all schools across the state, the Assam State School Education Board, Div- II has prepared the Academic Calendar for the Academic Session 2026-27 (1st April 2026 to 31st March 2027) for Higher Secondary and Senior Secondary School in the State.

**As per provision of the Assam State School Education Board Act, 2024 the erstwhile Board of Secondary Education, Assam (SEBA) and Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) have been merged with effect from 13th September, 2024 and the new board "Assam State School Education Board" has come into existence. Accordingly, Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) is now known as ASSAM STATE SCHOOL EDUCATION BOARD, DIVISION-II. In exercise of powers conferred under section 30 read with section 30.2.(B) of the Assam State School Education Act, 2024, the ASSEB, Division-II is for imparting secondary education for Class-XI (HS 1st Year) and Class-XII (HS 2nd Year).**

The monthly Academic Wall Calendar is for all Higher Secondary Schools and Senior Secondary Schools for the Session 2026-27, imparting Senior Secondary Course under ASSEB, Div-II. .

It is expected that the Institutions will follow this calendar towards improving the academic atmosphere in our State.

## General Instructions :

- The Heads of the institution(s) shall convene meeting with the teaching staff conveniently to discuss and finalize the academic activities in the light of this Calendar. The meeting shall finalize the class routine as per model routine given with this Calendar.
- The Heads of the institution(s) shall constitute different Committees (from the teachers) like
  - Academic Committee,
  - Examination Committee,
  - Festival Celebration Committee,
  - Students' Activities Committee,
  - Parent Teacher Relation Committee,
  - Unit Test Committee,
  - Co-curricular Activity Committee etc.

These Committees will be responsible for smooth functioning of different programs of the Institutions.
- Lessonwise distributions of the key subjects of Arts, Science & Commerce stream have been displayed in every month of the Academic Calendar. These are just some examples of lesson distributions in this calendar. **All teachers will prepare monthly lesson distribution of respective subject to cover the syllabus within the period.**
- Head of the Institutions shall ask the teachers to prepare subjectwise work schedule of those subjects which are not included in the action plan of this calendar and discuss the syllabi contents amongst the teachers of respective subject. The Academic Committee will take initiative in this plan.
- The regular classes shall begin from 9.15 A.M. onwards, everyday
- Full classes will be taken on all working days including Saturdays. **Saturday shall not be treated as half working day.**
- The Head of the Institutions should ensure and maintain the norms laid down in the Rules & Regulations notified by ASSEB, Div-II time to time in recognition, academic permission, conduct of examinations etc.
- The Institutions will prepare their own class routine, by following the model routine of ASSEB, Div-II published in this calendar, 2026-27
- The class routine as included in this Calendar shall be strictly followed in such a manner that the duration of period and total number of classes per subject are not reduced.
- The first period for Higher Secondary Classes is for 45 minutes duration. The last period is of 35 minutes. The other classes must be 40 minutes in all the institutions. It is to be maintained strictly.
- Dates of Holidays may be changed subject to Govt. Notification.**
- The Unit Tests shall be conducted as per schedule mentioned in the Academic Calendar. The records of such tests should be analyzed immediately after completion of each test and should be taken necessary remedial measures for academic improvement of the students. The Unit Test Committee will take initiative for proper execution.
- The ASSEB, Div-II will issue necessary instructions in due course of time for holding of Class-XI/Class-XII, submission of registration forms, examination forms etc.
- At the beginning of the academic session, it is imperative to discuss the syllabus and textbook for deriving the skills/competencies envisaged in the curriculum and syllabus. The Academic Committee will take initiative with the supervision of the Head of the Institution.
- It is expected that the Head of the Institutions will take necessary steps for proper implementation of this Academic Calendar for achieving desired level of academic improvement of the students in general, and of the institutions in particular.
- The Academic Calendar must be followed by the concerned Institutions for maintaining healthy academic atmosphere at the institution.
- Any suggestion for improvement of academic activities at Higher Secondary & Senior Secondary School is highly solicited for designing future course of action.**

ASSEB, Div-II (Erstwhile AHSEC) has been selecting a theme, to reflect at the Academic Calendar of every year for the sake of some knowledge and information to the students as well as to the teachers. Like previous years (such as, 150 years of Birth of Mahatma Gandhi, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, G-20, ISRO, Year of the Book etc.), ASSEB, Div-II has selected the theme on the **Legend of Assam Late Zubeen Garg** to be reflected at the Academic Calendar, 2026-27.

All heads of the institutions and all teachers are honorably requested to create an environment for tribute to Zubeen Garg and to keep alive of the creativity and humanism of the legend Zubeen Garg among the students. This is a sincere tribute to our heartthrob Zubeen Garg.

INFORMATIONS REGARDING CHANGE IN SYLLABUS & CURRICULUM

1. Change in Curriculum in 2026-27

There are some special and significant informations to all concerned Schools / Senior Secondary / Degree Colleges / Universities who impart the Higher Secondary Courses under ASSAM STATE SCHOOL EDUCATION BOARD, DIVISION-II.

❖ ASSEB, Div-II has made some changes in the curriculum of class XI and class XII. A revised curriculum has been prepared for H.S. level course. This revised curriculum had been implemented for Class -XI (H.S. 1st Year) effecting from the academic session 2025-26. Accordingly, it will be implemented for Class- XII (H.S. 2nd Year) from academic session 2026-27 .

❖ For the students of Science and Commerce stream English and MIL/Alt. English is compulsory to pass. They have to select another four (4) subjects from Group-B or C. The student must have to appear in six (6) subjects and the result will be declared as pass, only if the students will secure 33% of marks in aggregate, in spite of the fact that even if he/she fails in one subject out of the four elective subjects. However, passing in English and MIL/Alt.English is compulsory.

❖ For the students of Arts stream, English and MIL is compulsory to pass. They have to choose three (3) subjects from Group-B and one (1) subject from Group-C. The student must have to appear in six (6) subjects and the result will be declared as pass, only if the students will secure 33% of marks in aggregate, in spite of the fact that even if he/she fails in one subject out of the four elective subjects. However, passing in English and MIL/Alt.English is compulsory.


❖ For the skill based elective subject containing in Group-C, the apportionment of marks for practical and theoretical part will be in the ratio of 50:50, as mentioned at the syllabus of the specific subject.

2. Introduction of new drama book "Labhita" in MIL (Assamese).

### 3. Introduction of new subjects for Class- XI and Class- XII.

❖ ASSEB, Div-II has introduced the following new subjects to be implemented for Class XI and Class XII effective from the academic session 2026-27.

**(I) Costing & Taxation :** In continuation of the Board's initiative to strengthen and update the Commerce curriculum, a new subject "Costing & Taxation" has been introduced in Commerce Stream with effect from the academic session 2026-27, initially for Class-XI. The purpose of the new subject "Costing & Taxation" is to evolve nature of commerce and business practices. It is now considered necessary for students to acquire foundational knowledge in Costing and Taxation, including Goods and Services Tax (GST), at an early stage of their academic career. Early exposure to these concepts will enable students to develop practical understanding and professional competence, thereby preparing them for further studies and careers in commerce and allied fields. The detailed syllabus and prescribed textbook for the subject shall be made available in due course. Regarding implementation of this subject, a notification has been issued vide No: ASSEB/DIV-II/ACA/COS-TAX/2025/08/0538, date : 23/02/2026.

**(II) Sign Language :** To provide communication access to deaf and hard of hearing people in various settings in real life and to spread awareness about Indian Sign language (ISL) to support individuals with disabilities and as the implementation of NEP 2020 envisages inclusive education and use of ISL, the subject Sign Language will be introduced in colleges and schools. The teacher or resource person having B.Ed. in special education should be available in the Institution. Any such competent teacher available in any primary or upper primary or high school or resource person of SSA, he or she may take classes of this subject in nearby HSS/ SSS/College.

In view of the above, this subject Sign Language has been introduced for Class-XI in 2025-26. Accordingly this subject has been upgraded to Class-XII and implemented from the academic session 2026-27. A new Syllabus for Class-XII has been prepared. Based on this syllabus, a new textbook has been developed. The name of the textbook is "**Fundamentals of Sign Language Beyond the Basics, for Class-XII**".

**(III) Artificial Intelligence:** To improve the students to build digital literacy, critical thinking, creativity and problem-solving skills, the subject Artificial Intelligence will be introduced in colleges and schools. Any competent teacher having knowledge in AI/Computer Education available in any Higher Secondary/Senior Secondary school /Colleges, may take classes of this subject.

In view of the above, this subject Artificial Intelligence has been introduced for Class-XI in 2025-26. Accordingly this subject has been upgraded to Class-XII and implemented from the academic session 2026-27. A new Syllabus for Class-XII has been prepared. Based on this syllabus, a new textbook has been developed and published by ASSEB, Div-II for the students.

**(IV) Financial Literacy:** To help students to make informed financial decisions by an understanding of key financial facts and concepts, the Subject Financial Literacy will be introduced in colleges and schools. Any competent teacher available in any Higher Secondary /Senior Secondary School/Colleges may take classes of this subject.

In view of the above, this subject Financial Literacy has been introduced for Class-XI in 2025-26. Accordingly this subject has been upgraded to Class-XII and implemented from the academic session 2026-27. A new Syllabus for Class-XII has been prepared. Based on this syllabus, a new textbook has been developed and published by ASSEB, Div-II for the students.

❖ The training of teachers of these three subjects has been provided by ASSEB, Div-II, time to time.

### 4. Revision of syllabus of some subjects for Class-XII in 2026-27.

**i. Mathematics :** Mathematics is a common and most important subject for all three stream- i.e.- Arts, Science & Commerce. Keeping the view of practical knowledge of Mathematics, ASSEB, Div-II has introduced a project work of marks 20 for the students of Class-XII, from the academic session 2026-27. The marking pattern of maths will be theory: 80 and project: 20.

Similarly, for Class-XI also, a project work of marks 20 has been introduced in the subject Mathematics, which will be implemented from the academic session 2026-27.

**ii. Bihu :** As the subject Bihu is now become a skill based subject, so the marking pattern of Bihu has been changed to 50:50, in place of earlier 30:70. So, for Class-XII students from the academic session 2026-27, the marking pattern of Bihu in theory 50 & practical 50.

**iii. Sanskrit :** As per NEP, 2020 and NCF, 2023 the syllabus of the subject Sanskrit has been revised. Now the students will learn Sanskrit by Sanskrit -to- Sanskrit language. A project mark of 20 has been introduced in this new syllabus. Accordingly a new textbook for Class-XII has been developed and published for the students in 2026-27 for Class-XII.

**iv. Artificial Intelligence, Financial Literacy, Sign Language :** As these three subjects had been introduced for Class-XI in 2025-26, so accordingly new syllabi of these three subjects have been developed for Class-XII in 2026-27.

Based on these syllabi of these three subjects, new textbooks for Class-XII have been developed and published for the students in 2026-27.

**V. General Studies :** The study at the Secondary stage in classes 11&12 are compartmentalized through the studying of selected specialised subjects as required for higher studies in a specific direction. The compartmentalized studies couldn't provide much exposure to some vital disciplines/areas of study that are not covered in their specialized field. To overcome these issues, ASSEB, Div II has decided to offer General Studies as a compulsory audit subject for the students of all streams. The subject will be assessed internally and Grade will be awarded which will be reflected in the marks-sheet. The students must have to study the subject and appear in the internal examination otherwise their result in the final examination will be declared as INCOMPLETE.

### 5. Change of nomenclature of two subjects

As per demand of time and to cope our students in national level ASSEB, Div-II (Erstwhile AHSEC) has changed the nomenclature of two subjects, viz,

**Home Science (গৃহ বিজ্ঞান) to Community Science (সামূহিক বিজ্ঞান)**  
and **Salesmanship & Advertising to Sales Management & Advertising**  
to be implemented from the Academic Session 2024-25 for Class- XI and from the Academic Session 2025-26 for Class-XII. Accordingly, the syllabus of these subjects have been newly re-designed. The revised new syllabi of Community Science & Sales Management & Advertising for Class- XI and Class-XII are available at the official website [www.ahsec.assam.gov.in](http://www.ahsec.assam.gov.in)

The textbooks of Community Science for Class- XI & Class- XII are published in both of the medium Assamese and English, which are available for students in open market.

### 6. Introduction of New Textbooks :

**ASSEB, Div-II has introduced new textbooks for the session 2026-27 of the subjects Costing and Taxation, Economic Geography, Sign Language, Financial Literacy, Artificial Intelligence, Sanskrit , General Studies. The new textbooks are**

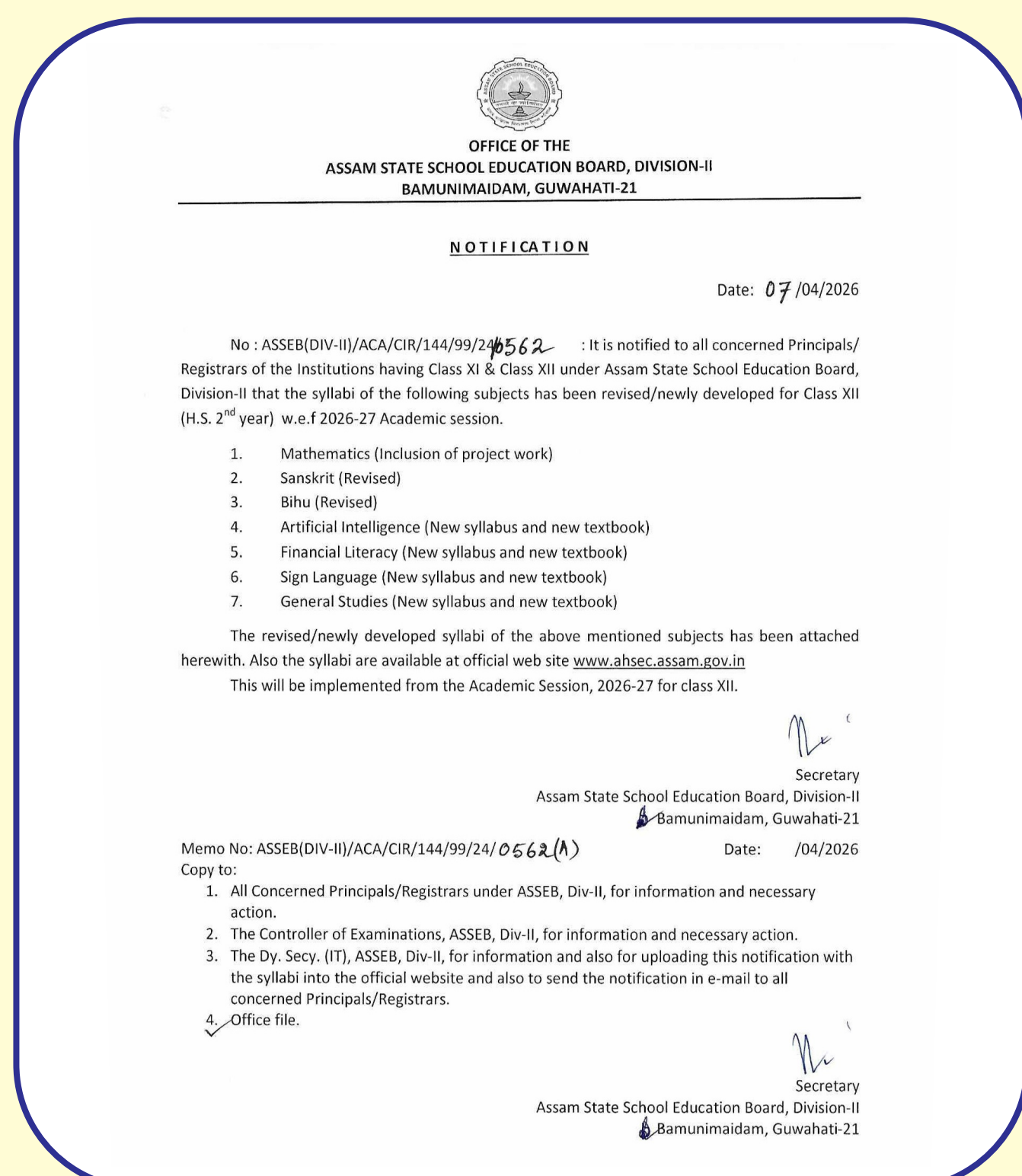

### 7. Introduction of Tai Language

As per direction of Hon'ble CM, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, AHSEC has introduced a new elective subject "Tai Language" in H.S. Course. It has been implemented from 2023-24 Academic Session. Accordingly, with the help of Purbanchal Tai Sahitya Sabha and Centre for Language Studies, Dibrugarh University, textbooks has been developed namely "Lit Kham", for Class- XI in 2023-24 and "Lit Kham", for Class- XII in 2024-25.

The textbook was inaugurated by Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam on 02.08.2023 at CM's office in a programme organized by Purbanchal Tai Sahitya Sabha.
